Sponsoring Classical Concerts (Fall – Winter – Spring)

\$1000 donation (cash or in-kind) = Associate Sponsorship of one event in one location

1. Your business will be listed as *Associate Sponsor* of an event or concert in all publicity and concert programs. Other sponsors may be listed for the same event.
2. Your business will be allowed to display promotional materials in the lobby before, during and after the performance.
3. Your business will be given space for a full-page ad in classical concert programs for one season.
4. Your business will be recognized in all classical concert programs for one season as a major donor.
5. Your business will be recognized and thanked for its support from the stage during the performance.
6. Complimentary tickets for the concert (and others upon request) will be made available.

\$3000 donation (cash or in-kind) = Exclusive Sponsorship of one classical concert in one location

1. Business will be listed as *Exclusive Sponsor* of one classical concert in one location in all publicity and concert programs. No other sponsors may be listed for the same event in that location. Example: “Target is Exclusive Sponsor of the Winter Classical Concert in Ottumwa”
2. Benefits (2-6) are the same as above.

\$10,000 donation (cash or in-kind) = Underwriter of one classical concert series in all three locations.

1. Business will be listed as *Underwriter* of one classical concert series in all three locations in all publicity and programs. No other sponsors will be listed for the same series.
2. All the other benefits (2-6) are the same as above
3. Donor’s reception for all employees to follow concert of their choice.

Sponsoring special events

Kidsymphony/Pops/Messiah Sing/Youth String Festival/School Tour Concerts/Artist-in-Residence

1. A business and/or individual who donates at least \$500 (cash or in-kind) would be listed as an Associate Sponsor in all publicity and event programs. In addition, each donor would be listed in the classical concert programs and thanked from the stage during the event
2. Donation amounts for *Exclusive Sponsors* or *Underwriters* would depend on the cost of the activity.

For 2008-2009, our budget figures are as follows:

Pops (one performance) = \$15,000

Kidsymphony (one performance) = \$2500

Messiah Sing! = \$3200

School Tour Concerts = \$3500

Youth String Festival = \$1500

Artist-in Residence = \$6000 (or \$2000 for one community)
